Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of an unorthodox well location for your Pan American State Well No. 1 to be located 2210 feet from the South line and 1660 feet from the West line of Section 23, Township 29 North, Range 11 West, Aztec-Fruitland Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that this unorthodox well location is based upon extreme topographic conditions in the SW/4 of said Section 23.

By authority granted me under provisions of Rule 104 of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby granted approval for the above described unorthodox well location. You must also obtain like approval from the U. S. Geological Survey if the well is located on land subject to the jurisdiction of the U. S. Geological Survey.
