I am writing this letter as agent for Mr. Roy L. Cook to request administrative approval for a non-standard or unorthodox location for a Fruitland-Pictured Cliffs well to be drilled in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 23, Township 29 North, Range 11 West, San Juan County, New Mexico, as is indicated on the enclosed Form C-128.

This request is made because a standard location would fall in a swamp and would cause undue operational difficulty and expense. The location as indicated is on a low bench or cliff above the swamp and is accessible.


