Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of an unorthodox well location for your Reed B-33 Well No. 2 to be located 1650 feet from the North line and 330 feet from the East line of Section 23, Township 20 South, Range 36 East, Eumont Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that this unorthodox well location is occasioned by the recompletion of a well previously drilled to another horizon.

By authority granted me under provisions of Order No. R-1670, you are hereby granted an exception for the above described unorthodox well location. You must also obtain like approval from the U. S. Geological Survey if the well is located on land subject to the jurisdiction of the U. S. Geological Survey.
