Dear Mr. Bayless:

Reference is made to your application for approval of an unorthodox well location for your Bernie Well No. 1 to be located 1450 feet from the North line and 450 feet from the East line of Section 6, Township 26 North, Range 1 East, undesignated pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that this unorthodox well location is based upon extreme topographic conditions in said Section 6.

By authority granted me under provisions of Rule 104 (f) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby granted approval for the above-described unorthodox well location. You must also obtain like approval from the U. S. Geological Survey if the well is located on land subject to the jurisdiction of the U. S. Geological Survey.
