
Dear Sirs:

Mr. R. L. Bayless, operator of the above proposed test well, has advised that the Commission has requested a waiver from Mobil Oil Company prior to approving an unorthodox location.

Due to adverse terrain, we agree with Mr. Bayless in that the test location for the exploratory test would be 1450' south of the north line and 450' west of the east line, of Section 6, Township 26 North, Range 1 East. Therefore, we hereby respectfully request the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission's consideration in granting such approval.

The proposed test well is a farmout of our Lease No. N-58, which is Federal Lease New Mexico 041, dated September 1, 1951.
