Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of an unorthodox well location for your San Juan 28-7 Well No. 114 to be located 990 feet from the South line and 2250 feet from the West line of Section 22, Township 28 North, Range 7 West, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that this unorthodox well location is based upon extreme topographic conditions in the SW/4 of said section.

Inasmuch as El Paso Natural Gas Company owns all offsetting acreage, it is possible for immediate approval to be granted. Therefore, by authority granted me under the Special Rules and Regulations of the South Blanco Pictured Cliffs Pool, you are hereby granted an exception for the above described unorthodox well location.
