Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of an unorthodox well location for your Federal "H" Well No. 1 to be located 1060.29 feet from the North line and 2296.91 feet from the East line of Section 24, Township 28 South, Range 2 West, NMPN, Dona Ana County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that this unorthodox well location is based upon extreme topographic conditions in the area, and that the well is a wildcat.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 104 (2) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby granted approval for the above-described unorthodox well location.
