We have contacted Amerada Petroleum Company and requested them to write a letter to the Commission stating that they have no objection, which they assure us they have done.

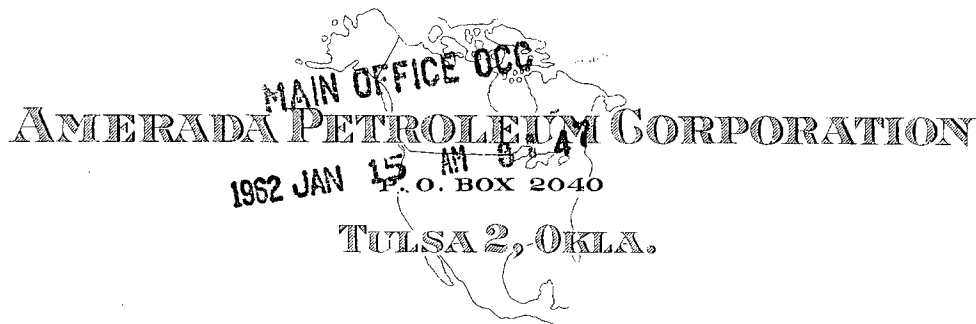
