Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter of August 28, 1963, wherein you request authority to drill your Plaine Unit Well No. 4 at an unorthodox location 1930 feet from the South line and 660 feet from the West line of Section 21, Township 19 South, Range 32 East, Lusk Morrow Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

Inasmuch as Commission Order R-2534 has already approved a non-standard location for this proposed well 1980 feet from the South line and 660 feet from the West line of Section 21, and the movement of the location 30 feet South will not in effect be any more unorthodox than that which has already been approved, this office has no objection to the proposed location.

You are, therefore, hereby authorized to drill your Plaine Unit Well No. 4 at the above-described new location.
