Dear Jim:

The above location has been staked at 1150' from the south line and 1350' from the west line of the section, which would appear to be the least expensive location in the SW/4 of the section. There are a couple of other places that would come a little closer to being a standard location, but they would cost more to build. One of these being 1150' from the south line and 1650' from the west line and the other one approximately 1450' from the south and 2310' from the west. They estimated the cost of a road into the location at around \$12,000.
