RE: Request for exception of well location -
Basin-Dakota Gas Pool

Dear Mr. Porter:

Caulkins Oil Company completed Well No. T-132, located 660' FNL, 760' FEL of Sec. 9, TS26N, R6W, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico as a Tocito Oil Producer. This well was completed January 15, 1952 at a total depth of 6,730' and currently the well is shut down as an uneconomical producer from the Tocito Oil Formation.

Caulkins Oil Company now desires to deepen this well to an approximate depth of 7500' and complete the well as a Dakota Producer in the Basin-Dakota Pool. Subject well was an orthodox location for the South Blanco-Tocito Pool, but an exception is required to conform to the Basin-Dakota Pool Field Rules. All of the offset acreage as shown by the attached plat is owned by Caulkins Oil Company.

Caulkins Oil Company request approval to deepen Well T-132 as an unorthodox well located in the Basin-Dakota Pool. Administrative approval of this well in accordance with the provisions of Order No. R-1670-C, as amended and Conservation Commission Rule 104-F is hereby requested.
