J.M. Huber Corporation is filing intention to drill on their Atlantic State No. 1 well. It is to be located 660' from south line and 410' from west line of Section 16, township 8S, Range 36 E, Roosevelt County, New Mexico. Per Rule 4 of Special Rules and Regulations for the South Prairie Devonian Pool, Roosevelt County, New Mexico, adopted by the Commission in Case No. 3881, Order No. R-3533, dated October 23, 1968, we are making application for well location in excess of 150 feet from the center of the governmental quarter-quarter section. This is necessitated by existing wells, roads and Roosevelt County Electric Co-op power lines.



Gentlemen:

J.M. Huber Corporation is filing an application with the Oil Conservation Commission of the State of New Mexico to drill a Devonian test at the following-described location, to-wit:

410' FWL and 660' FSL of Section 16,  
T-8-S, R-36-E, Roosevelt County, New Mexico

Rule 4 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the South Prairie Devonian Pool, Roosevelt County, New Mexico, adopted by the Commission in Case No. 3881, Order No. R-3533 dated October 23, 1968, requires the location of each well within 150' of the center of a governmental quarter-quarter section or lot.

As you know, there is a producing oil well located 660' FSWL of Section 16-45-36E, Roosevelt County, New Mexico. Because of power lines on the lease owned by the Roosevelt County Electric Co-op south of this well as well as west, Huber hereby requests from you a waiver of the aforementioned Rule 4 as an offset operator. The above mentioned location will be 350' west of the existing oil well.

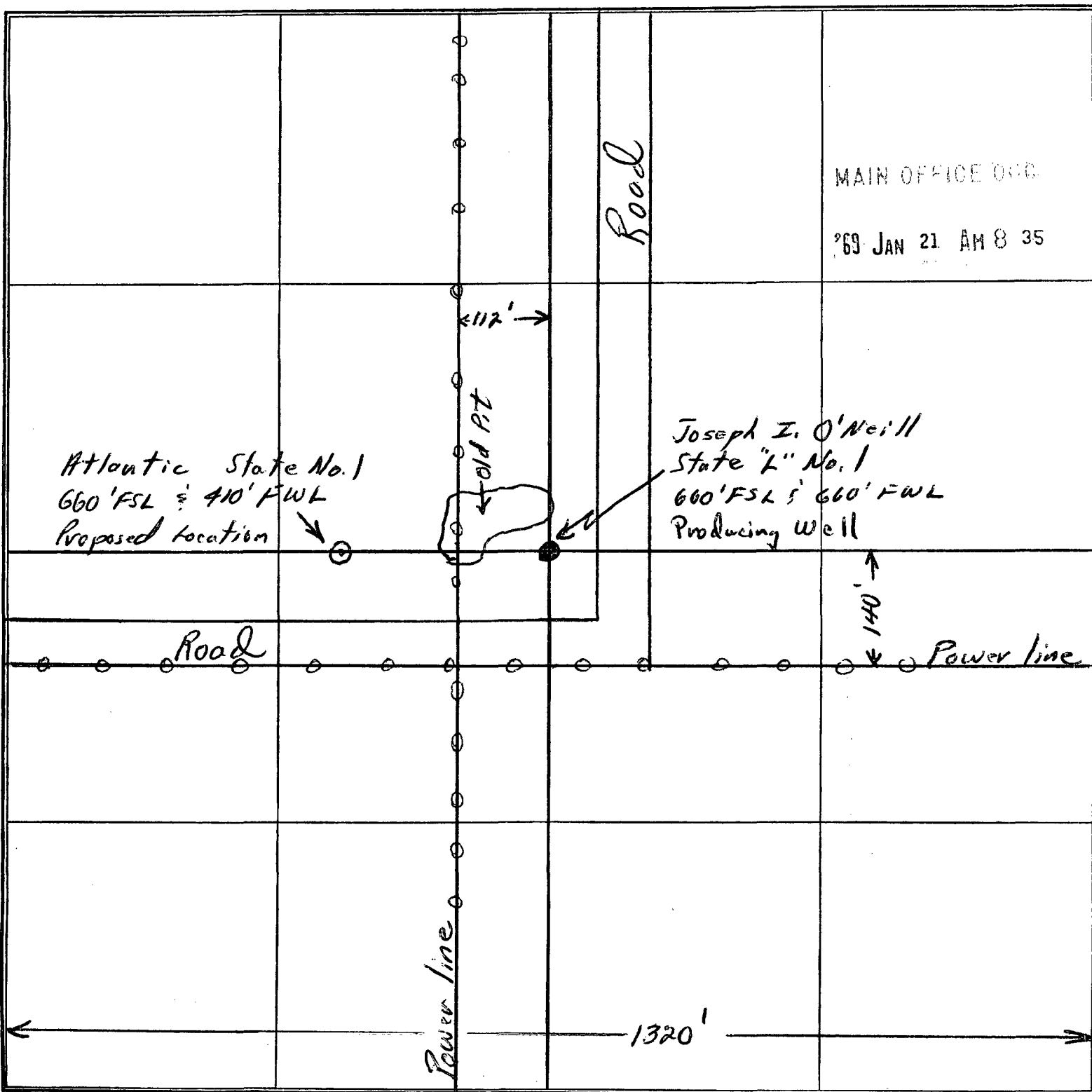
