Gentlemen:

Midwest Oil Corporation requests approval of an unorthodox location for the captioned well. The attached plat shows the offset operators and location of the well at 330' FSL and 1650' FEL of section 35, T-9-S, R-33-E.

Neville G. Penrose, Inc. originally drilled and plugged the well at this location in 1958. Midwest Oil Corporation re-entered the well in December, 1968, and completed it as a Bough "C" producer. The necessary forms for the re-entering and completing the well have been filed with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission in Hobbs.
