Administrative Order NSL-446

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of the following infill producing wells in your West Pearl Queen Unit Waterflood Project, West Pearl Queen Unit Area, Pearl-Queen Pool, at unorthodox locations in Township 19 South, Range 35 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico:

West Pearl Queen Unit Well No. 166, to be located 105 feet from the South line and 1325 feet from the East line of Section 28;

West Pearl Queen Unit Well No. 167, to be located 1215 feet from the South line and 1325 feet from the East line of Section 29; and

West Pearl Queen Unit Well No. 168, to be located 1150 feet from the North line and 1150 feet from the East line of Section 31.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Order No. R-2729, as amended by Order No. R-2729-A, the above-described unorthodox locations are hereby approved.

Administrative Order NSL-444 is hereby superseded.
