In accordance with telephone conversation with Mr. George Hatch, we are returning Administrative Order NSL-444. This Order granted approval for three infill producing wells in the West Pearl Queen Unit Waterflood Project, Lea County, New Mexico. A survey for staking the well locations indicated various obstructions such as power lines, etc.; therefore, it is necessary to change the location for two of the wells.


It is respectfully requested that Administrative Order NSL-444 be revised to show the following corrected locations:

West Pearl Queen Unit Well No. 166 - 105' FSL & 1325' FEL Sec. 28
West Pearl Queen Unit Well No. 167 - 1215' FSL & 1325' FEL Sec. 29
West Pearl Queen Unit Well No. 168 - No change

The corrected locations for Wells No. 166 and 167 still qualify for administrative approval under Order No. R-2729-A issued in Case No. 4114.
