Gentlemen:

We have recently plugged back our Bridges State No. 1 to the Abo formation, which was originally drilled and completed in the Morrow and later in the Wolfcamp formation. This well is located in Unit A of Section 11, T-17-S, R-34-E, Lea County, New Mexico and will be placed in the North Vacuum-Abo Pool. The pool rules require that a well be located within 200 feet of the center of either the NW/4 or the SE/4 of the quarter section, and our well is located in the center of the NE/4 of the quarter section thus creating a non-standard location. We would appreciate Administrative approval as provided for in Rule 5 of the Special Rules covering the North Vacuum-Abo Pool.

All offset operators have been notified of this application by certified mail.


