



Attached to this letter are eleven waivers for permission to deepen the J. J. Christmann #4 Townsend (located 660' from the south and west of Section 4, T-16S, R-35E, Lea County, New Mexico) to the Morrow gas sand. The twenty day waiting period for this specific location is up on the 18th of October. There are thirteen touching owners to this unit (S/2 of Section 4). Of the two touching owners that I do not have waivers from, Imperial American Management Company of Houston and Amoco, the Imperial American people have told me by telephone that they do not intend to protest but that they do not have anybody around to sign a waiver letter. Their interest is operated by Avance Oil & Gas Company, Inc., which has signed.

Amoco is joining us in this operation by farming out the NW/4 of the SE/4 of Section 4 to the gas unit. They are not otherwise touching owners. They will sign a waiver, but the machinery has not moved yet. This makes no objections from any of the owners.

It sure would be a great favor to get this location approved as early as possible, since I'm due to get operations going on the deepening by November 1st of 1972.
