
The subject well was drilled as a Devonian oil well test to a total depth of 9,420 feet and proved to be non-productive at this depth. The Morrow zone indicated to be productive and the well was ultimately completed from the Morrow at a depth of 9,174-9,202 feet as a gas well.

The dedicated acreage has been changed from the original 40 acres surrounding this well to 320 acres consisting of the north half of Section 12.

It is respectfully requested that Administrative approval be granted for the subject well to be considered as an unorthodox location.
