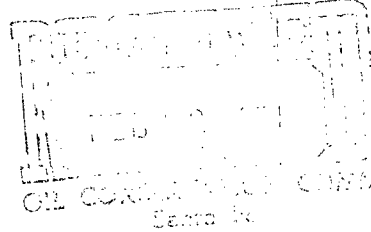

Dear Sir:

Gulf Oil Corporation requests your administrative approval for an unorthodox location for our Arnott-Ramsay (NCT-F) well No. 5, located 660' FNL & 560' FEL, Section 36, 25-S, 37-E, presently producing from the Justis Blinebry zone, which Gulf proposes to clean out to approximately 6317' and complete as an undesignated Abo gas well in the approximate interval 6206' to 6276'. Providing the Abo zone is productive, application will be made for a Justis Blinebry - Abo gas dual. In support of this application the following facts are submitted:

1. Rule 104-B-1(a) requires that a gas well completed in this formation be located on a tract consisting of 160 surface contiguous acres and shall not be located closer than 660' from any outer boundry of such tract, necessating this request.
2. The attached map shows the location of the well and the proposed 160 acre proration unit outlined in red.
3. Applicant believes this proposal is economically feasible since this well was originally drilled to 6355' and this zone flowed at the rate of approximately 1800 MCFPD on drill stem test.
4. The completion of this well in this formation represents reasonable development of this zone.
5. Copies of this application were mailed to each offset operator on February 20, 1974.

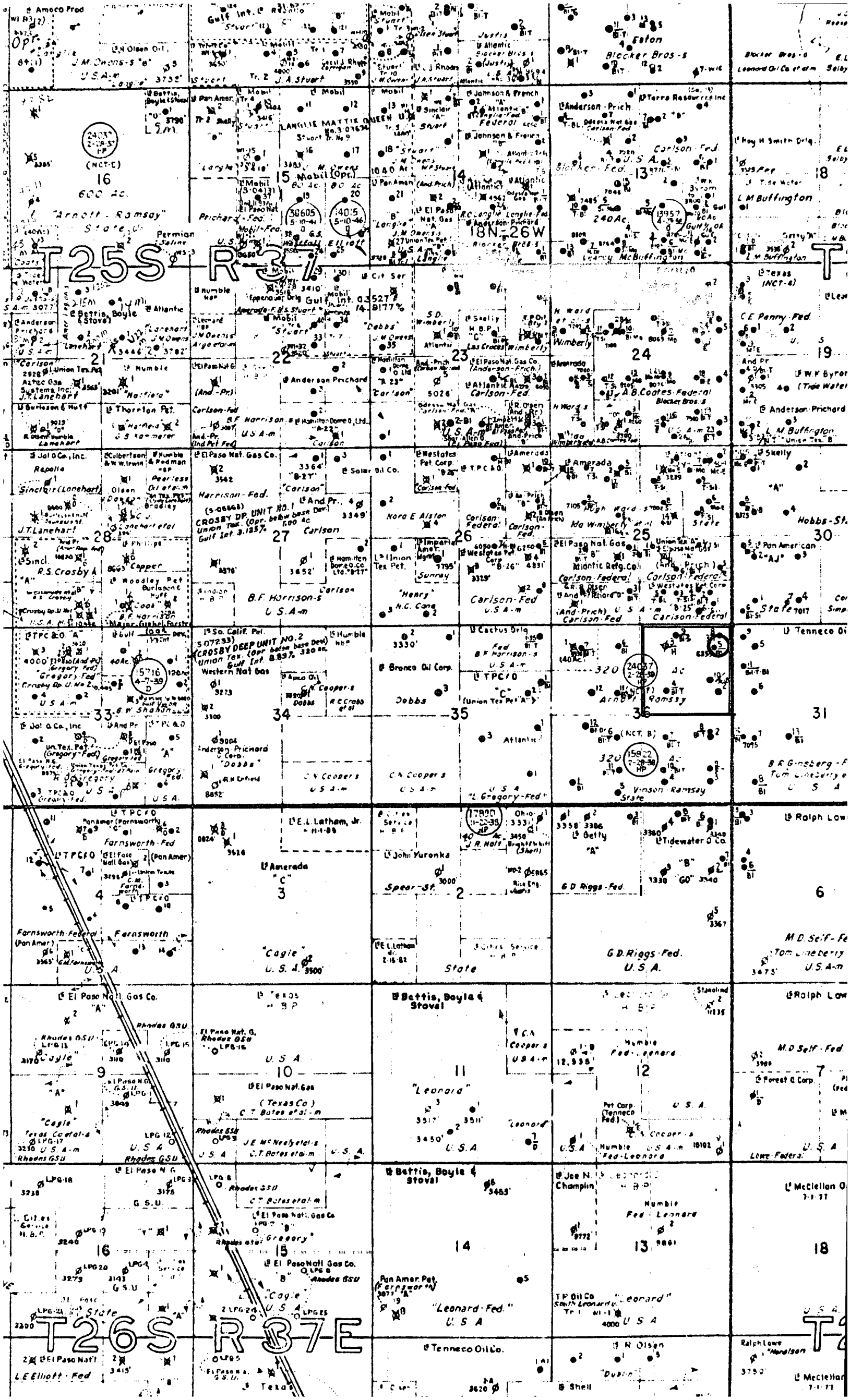

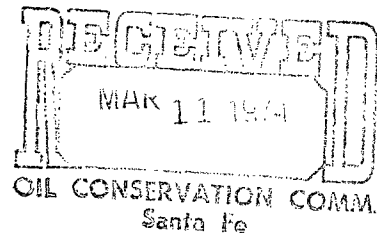
