



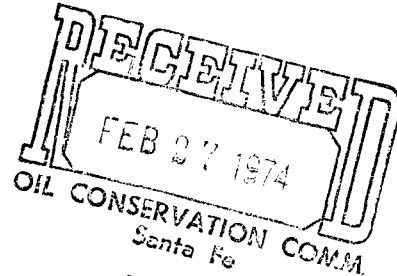

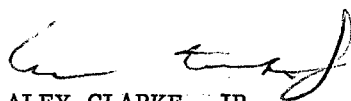
Amoco Production Company respectfully submits this application for an Unorthodox well location, due to existing topographical conditions, for the Trail Unit Canyon Well No. 1. The proposed location to be 900' FNL X 500' FWL, Section 11, T-24-S, R-23-E, Eddy County, New Mexico.

The proposed site is for a 10,800' Wildcat Morrow gas test well with a 320 acre proration unit dedication to consist of the N/2 of Section 11. Costs for a drill site in any other location would be prohibitive due to the terrain and surface conditions. Surface water ponds and a windmill preclude possible other locations in the N/2 of the section.

Attached is a topographical map of the area and location together with a plat of the unit and offset operators.

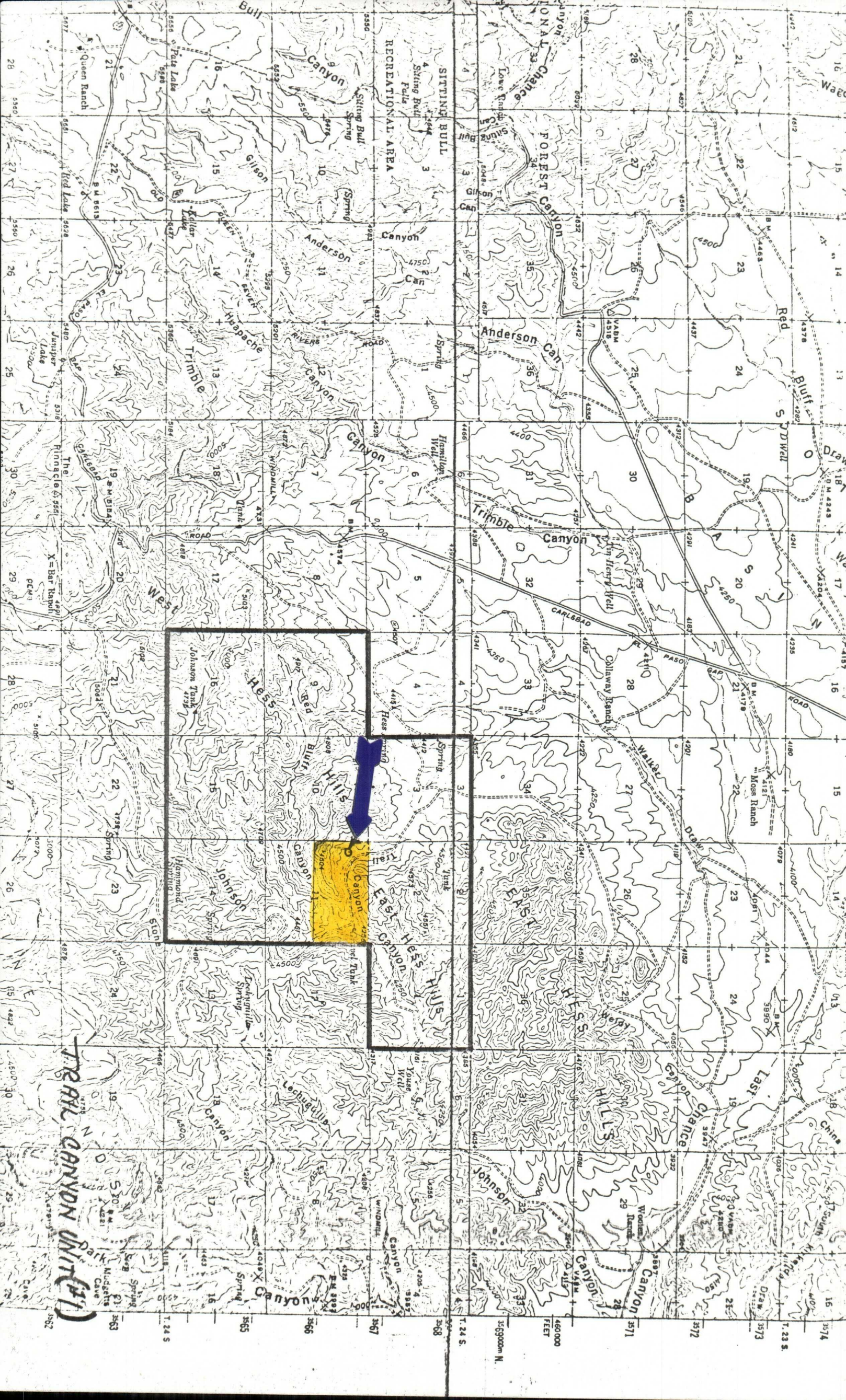
