Dear Mr. Nutter:

Reference is made to Rule 4 and 5 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the North Dagger Draw Upper Pennsylvanian Pool entered by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission December 11, 1973 in case #5117, Order R-4691. Rule 4 requires that each well be located no nearer than 660 feet to the side line nor nearer than 1,980 feet to the end border line nor nearer than 330 feet to any quarter section. Rule 5 permits the Secretary-Director of the Commission to grant an exception to Rule 4 when necessitated by topographic conditions or "recompletion of a well previously drilled to another horizon".

The Barbara-Federal #4 was a reentry of a previously drilled well by the Yates Petroleum #1 A-0 Kincaid-Federal. It was drilled to a total depth of 8070' and was plugged as a dry and abandoned hole after production attempts on March 28, 1966.

I reentered the old Yates hole, renaming it the Barbara-Federal #4 and deviated the hole at a depth of approximately 3700' and redrilled the hole to a depth of 7917'. Arriving at the objective depth at a deviation of 10°, I recompleted the well in the interval from 7800-7816 and 7736-52'. This is essentially the same zone, being the Cisco Canyon, that is producing in my Barbara-Federal #1, #2, #3, and in Section 30, my Dagger Draw Working Interest Unit #1.

I respectfully request that the Secretary waive the hearing requirement in view of the fact that this was a reentry of a formerly drilled hole, and I enclose for your examination a copy of a wire from AMOCO as evidence to no objection to an allowable be assigned. Yates Petroleum Company will forward a similar type instrument directly to you.

Your urgent attention is requested to this matter.
