





APPLICATION

HARVEY E. YATES COMPANY, applicant herein, by its attorneys states:

1. Applicant, pursuant to a farmout agreement from Cities Service Oil Company, is the operator of the oil and gas rights below the base of the San Andres formation underlying the following lands in Lea County, New Mexico:

Township 17 South, Range 32 East, N.M.P.M.

Section 30: S/2

2. Applicant proposes to re-enter the Ashmun & Hilliard Oil Company et al Federal Carper Well No. 1-30 located 330 feet from the South line and 1,650 feet from the East line of said Section 30, drilled to a total depth of 8,176 feet and plugged and abandoned in 1964, and deepen said well to a depth sufficient to test the Morrow series of the Pennsylvanian system and to dedicate the S/2 of said Section 30 to the well.

3. A plat showing the ownership of all leases offsetting the spacing unit for which the unorthodox location is sought is hereto attached and by reference made a part hereof. All of the wells in the offset proration or spacing units are completed in the Grayburg-San Andres formation and are shown on the plat attached hereto.

WHEREFORE, applicant prays:


