I am proposing to re-enter the Stanolind #1 State "AF" located 1787 feet from the North line and 467 feet from the East line of Section 3, Township 17 South, Range 35 East, Lea County, New Mexico. This well was drilled to a total depth of 13,000 feet and plugged and abandoned in 1954. As this is a non-standard location it is requested that we be given administrative approval to re-enter this hole.

I am the operator of all acreage shown on the attached plat as 'West'. Exxon, Houston Natural Gas and Texaco, as off-set operators, were notified of this proposed re-entry in September.
