Gentlemen:

Reference is made to Woosley Oil Company's application for approval of a non-standard location for their Navajo "AA" Well No. 26 to be located 700 feet from the North line and 2480 feet from the East line of Section 18, Township 32 North, Range 17 West, NMPM, North Many Rocks Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico.

Since there are no offsetting operators, the waiting period prescribed by Rule 104 F may be dispensed with in this instance.
