Dear Sir:

We sent a letter dated October 25, 1978 requesting administrative approval to drill the Navajo Indian No. 6-A well on a non standard location due to topographical reasons. We failed to send copies of the topographical map with the application. We also failed to nominate the formations which we intend to complete the well in.

It is our intention to drill this well to the Blanco Mesaverde pool and formation. If there is a Pictured Cliffs zone of commercial quality in the well we will apply for a dual completion approval. If the logs show that there is not a commercial quality sand present in the Pictured Cliffs formation it will be completed as a single Blanco Mesaverde well.

We have attached copies of the topographical maps of this proposed location which is 2240 feet from the South line and 845 feet from the West line of Section 6, Township 26 North, Range 8 West, N.M.P.M., San Juan County, New Mexico.

It is respectfully requested that Supron Energy Corporation be granted administrative approval to drill the Navajo Indian No. 6-A well on a non standard location due to topographical reasons.

The proposed well would be located 2240 feet from the South line and 845 feet from the West line of Section 6, Township 26 North, Range 8 West, N.M.P.M., San Juan County, New Mexico.

The on site inspection reveals that any standard location in this drilling unit would be situated in the Blanco Canyon Arroyo. We have spotted the well in the only location available in this drilling block that would be out of the arroyo bed.


