
Amoco Production Company hereby makes application for unorthodox location for the Jackson #3 Well at the above referenced location in the Basin Fruitland Coal Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico. This well was originally drilled to the Basin Dakota Pool at an approved non-standard location under Administrative Order NSL-1001 dated December 8, 1978. Amoco now wishes to recomplete the well to the Basin Fruitland Coal Pool. This location would be unorthodox since it does not conform to the NE/SW pattern in the pool. Under Rule 8 of Order No. R-8768, the Division Director may grant exception to the location requirements without hearing for recompletion of wells previously drilled to deeper horizons at approved unorthodox location for such horizons.

In addition, this well will be dedicated to a non-standard unit consisting of the S/2 Section 10, T28N-R9W. This is necessitated by variation in legal subdivision of the U.S. Public Land Survey. The unit consists of an entire governmental section not less than 70% or more than 130% of a standard gas proration unit. Under Rule 5 of Order R-8768-A this non-standard unit may be approved by the Supervisor of the Aztec District office of the Division. Attached are copies of the form C-102.



 MAEZ / TAS Area







