This is a request for administrative approval for an unorthodox gas well location in the Basin Dakota pool.


It is intended to locate the El Paso Natural Gas Company's San Juan 29-7 Unit #113 at 945' from the North line and 2300' from the East line of Section 29, T-29-N, R-7-W, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

Topographical reasons dictate where the location is situated. The original plat shows the North half of Section 29 dedicated to this well, but a commercial well in this section already has the West half dedicated to it. A new plat has been issued showing the East half dedicated to the San Juan 29-7 Unit #113 (see attached plat).

All operators of proration units offsetting the proposed unorthodox location have been notified of this application by certified mail.

El Paso Natural Gas Company has requested administrative approval for an unorthodox gas well location in the Basin Dakota pool.

It is intended to locate the El Paso Natural Gas Company's San Juan 29-7 Unit #113 at 945' from the North line and 2300' from the East line of Section 29, T-29-N, R-7-W, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

Topographical reasons dictate where the location is situated. The original plat shows the North half of Section 29 dedicated to this well, but a commercial well in this section already has the West half dedicated to it.
