

Please accept this letter as an application for a request of administrative approval for an unorthodox location of the Max Wilson, Inc. No. 1 Wildernhel located 1,720' FSL and 920' FWL of Section 24, T.20S, R.21E, Eddy County, New Mexico. The rough terrain on this location has necessitated the unorthodox location.

A topographic map is attached hereto with our survey plat designating the $W\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 24 to this well. Exxon Company, U. S.
