Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for a non-standard location for your White Ranch Well No. 3 located 990 feet from the South line and 660 feet from the West line of Section 34, Township 11 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, White Ranch Siluro-Devonian Pool, Chaves County, New Mexico.

You are hereby authorized to simultaneously dedicate a 320-acre non-standard proration unit consisting of the S/2 of Section 34, Township 11 South, Range 29 East to the above-described well and your White Ranch Well No. 2 located 1980 feet from the South line and 660 feet from the West line of said Section 34. Further, you are hereby permitted to produce the allowable from any of the wells on the proration unit in any proportion.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 104 F of the Division Rules and Regulations, the above-described unorthodox location is hereby approved.
