Dear Mr. Ramey:

This is a request for administrative approval for an unorthodox gas well location in the Basin Dakota pool.

It is intended to locate the El Paso Natural Gas Company's San Jacinto #6E at 1090' from the North line and 640' from the East line of Section 20, T-29-N, R-10-W, San Juan County, New Mexico.

Extremely rough terrain, the location of existing powerlines, and the location of existing pipelines in the northeast corner of this section makes it impossible to build an orthodox gas well location.

All operators of proration units offsetting the proposed unorthodox location have been notified of this application by certified mail.

Plats showing the proposed well location and the terrain of Section 20, along with an ownership plat, are attached.

Gentlemen:

El Paso Natural Gas Company has requested administrative approval for an unorthodox gas well location in the Basin Dakota pool.

It is intended to locate the El Paso Natural Gas Company's San Jacinto #6E at 1090' from the North line and 640' from the East line of Section 20, T-29-N, R-10-W, San Juan County, New Mexico.

Extremely rough terrain, the location of existing powerlines, and the location of existing pipelines in the northeast corner of this section makes it impossible to build an orthodox gas well location.




