Your notification to the Division that Flag-Redfern Oil Company has no objection to the location as soon as possible, would be appreciated.

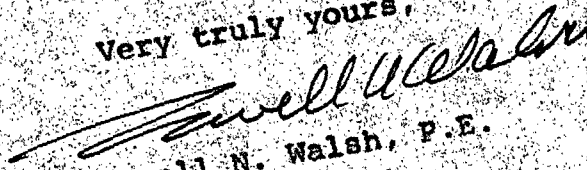
