Marathon Oil Company respectfully requests approval for an unorthodox location for the above referenced well located at:

1980' FNL & 990' FEL
Sec. 13, T-20S, R-34E
Lea County, New Mexico

This well was drilled as an Ellenburger wildcat, at an orthodox location; T.D. of 16,553' was reached February 2, 1980. Subsequent logging showed no Ellenburger pay, the well has been plugged back to 14,388'. Devonian pay has been found through perforations at 14,345' - 351'.

As seen on the accompanying plat, this well is located within the boundaries of the Marathon operated Lea Unit, so there are no offset operators.

We also request approval for simultaneous dedication between Lea Unit Well No. 9 and the referenced well. The attached C102 shows the dedication in question.


