

The discharge was caused by a packer leak or possible tubing failure, to be determined when well is pulled. A vacuum truck was called and 23 bbls of fluid were recovered. The downhole well problem will be repaired.

200'X75' of dry black soil/caliche rock road, pad and pasture with no cows present. The spill site will be delineated and remediated in accordance with NMOCD guidelines.
