Gentlemen:

RE: Administrative Order MSP-6

Reference is made to your application of August 27, 1954, for approval of a 120-acre non-standard gas proration unit covering the E/2 of Section 6, Township 22 South, Range 36 East, N27W, Lea County, New Mexico, said unit to be ascribed to your Glesson Well No. 1.

By authority granted me under provisions of Rule 5, Section (b)-6 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Joint Gas Pool as set forth in Order N-520, you are hereby authorized to operate the above-described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto as of October 1, 1954, in accordance with pool rules.

I should like to remind you further, in line with my letter to you of September 1, 1954, that it is quite possible that your Glesson Wells No. 4 and No. 8, which are also in this unit, may be reclassified as Joint Gas wells. If such reclassification materializes, the production from all three wells will thereupon be charged against the allowable assigned to the unit granted hereunder.

able to be assigned the #1 well.

Gentlemen:

By means of this application Cities Service Oil Company wishes to  
state the following:

1. Cities Service Oil Company is the owner of an oil and gas lease covering the E/2 of Section 6-22S-36E, Lea County, New Mexico, known as the Closson Lease, and containing 320 acres, more or less.
2. That Closson No. 1, located 2310' from the South Line and 1650' from the East Line of Section 6-22S-36E, is a gas well producing from the Jalmat Gas Pool and is assigned an acreage allowable of 160 acres.
3. That the Closson No. 1 is the only gas well on the E/2 of Section 6 producing from the Jalmat Gas Pool.
4. That Order No. R-520 permits proration units of up to 640 acres in the Jalmat Gas Pool.
5. That the Closson No. 1 meets the spacing regulations for an acreage assignment of 320 acres.
6. That waivers have been sent to all operators owning interests in the section in which this non-standard gas proration unit is situated for submission to the Commission, if they have no objection to this application.

It is therefore respectfully requested that the Commission increase

the acreage allowable of the subject well to 320 acres to include all of the E/2 of Section 6-22S-36E. A Gas Well Plat showing Closson No. 1 and all other oil wells in the E/2 of Section 6 is attached.

Gas Well Plat




