Dear Ms. Hatfield:

Reference is made to your applications dated April 1 and May 7, 1997 for two unorthodox Jalmat gas well locations within an existing non-standard 320.51-acre gas spacing and proration unit ("GPU") for said Jalmat Gas Pool comprising Lots 1 and 2, the S/2 NE/4, and SE/4 (E/2 equivalent) of Section 6, Township 22 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. Said GPU was established by Division Administrative Order NSP-6, dated September 30, 1954 and had dedicated thereon the Tom Closson Well No. 1 (API No. 30-025-08801) located at a standard gas well location 2310 feet from the South line and 1650 feet from the East line (Unit J) of said Section 6.

It is our understanding that the subject wells in this application have recently been plugged back from the South Eunice-Seven Rivers Queen Pool and recompleted up-hole into the Jalmat Gas Pool.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2(d) of the "General Rules for the Prorated Gas Pools of New Mexico/Special Rules and Regulations for the Jalmat Gas Pool", as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, the following two described wells located at unorthodox Jalmat gas well locations are hereby approved:

*Tom Closson Well No. 5*  
*660' FNL & 1980' FEL (Lot 2/Unit B)*  
*API No. 30-025-08805*

*Tom Closson Well No. 6*  
*660' FSL & 1980' FEL (Unit O)*  
*API No. 30-025-08806*

Also, you are hereby authorized to simultaneously dedicate Jalmat Gas production from the Tom Closson Well No. 1 with the Tom Closson Well Nos. 5 and 6. Furthermore, Southwest Royalties, Inc. is hereby permitted to produce the allowable assigned the subject GPU from all three wells in any proportion.
