Dear Mr. Okerson:

By letter of July 24, 1980, you requested approval of the unorthodox location of Amoco's Federal "BN" Well No. 1 in Section 17, Township 22 South, Range 26 East, Eddy County, New Mexico.

This unorthodox location is not administratively approvable for the stated reason that it is to "preserve the intrinsic value of the rancher's view." However, this site was inspected by OCD and BLM personnel on September 24, 1980, and is approvable on topographic grounds considering the heavy cut and fill operations required at the initial proposed location and a high pressure gas pipeline at an alternate orthodox location which was considered.

Upon receipt of supplemental information as outlined above and a readable topographic plat clearly showing the features discussed above, the application may be approved.




