





Dear Mr. Stamets:

A C-102 Well Location and Acreage Dedication plat is attached. It shows the original location for the subject well to be on a hill and very close to high-way US-285. It would require a twenty-foot cut in the hill and the pad would be almost touching the road. For these reasons we seek administrative approval of a non-standard location 1270-feet from the south line and 810-feet from the east line of Section 11, township-21-south, range-25-east. This location would be on flat terrain and would also be well back from the highway.
