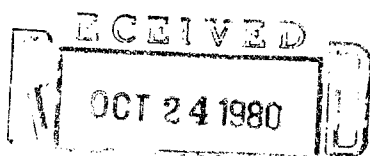

Gentlemen:

Marbob Energy Corporation respectfully requests administrative approval of an unorthodox location for their State CJ Com. No. 1. The following information relative to this request is submitted for your consideration.

1. The State CJ Com. No. 1 is located 1654.9 feet from the north line and 1650 feet from the east line of section 24, township 20 south, range 26 east, Eddy County, New Mexico.
2. The proration unit for this well will consist of the north half of section 24.
3. The basis for this request is to obtain approval for a recompletion in the Wolfcamp horizon for the subject well, which was originally drilled to and completed in the Morrow horizon.
4. A plat showing the ownership of all offset leases and all completed wells is attached.
5. All offset proration unit or spacing unit operators have been supplied with a copy of this request by certified mail.

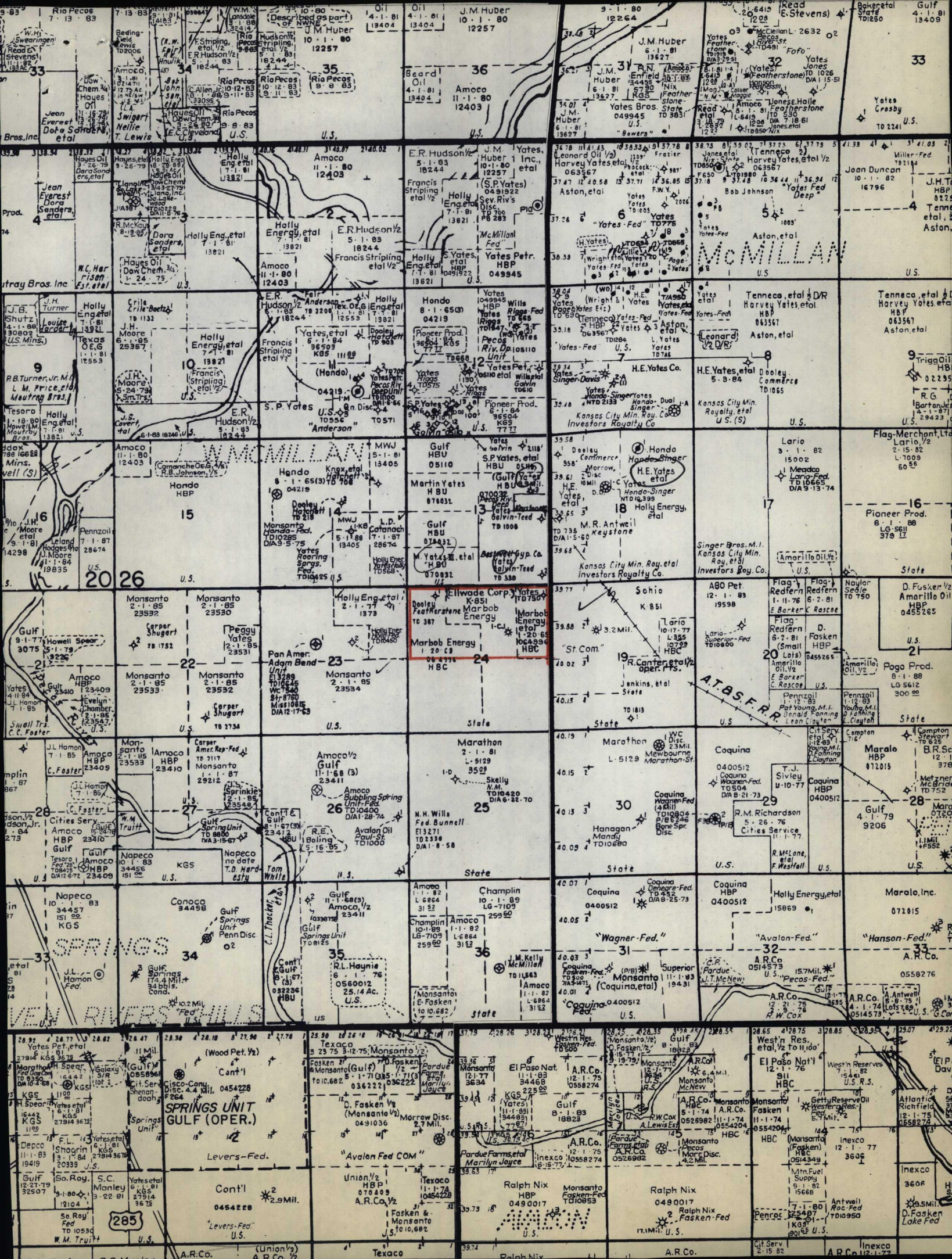

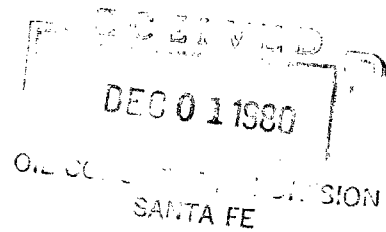
