



Maddox Energy plans to plug back and recomplete the Pardue Farms 27 No. 1 located in Unit H, 1980' from the north line and 990' from the east line of Section 27, T-23-S, R-28-E in the Bone Spring formation. This was originally a Morrow well and was drilled prior to development of Bone Spring production in Section 23, approximately three-quarters of a mile northeast.
