Gentlemen:


Cities Service Company respectfully request administrative approval for a non-standard location for their Government AK Well No. 1, located 2130' FSL, and 1980' FEL of Section 7-T19S-R21E, Eddy County, New Mexico.

It was originally planned to drill and complete this proposed well in the Morrow formation with a 320, the E/2 of Section 7, acreage dedication. After testing the Morrow formation with negative results this well was plugged back and completed in the Abo formation and only the SE/4, instead of the E/2, of Section 7 will be dedicated to this completed well.

With the dedication of only the SE/4 of the section it causes this location to fall 510' from the north lease line of the dedicated acreage which is less than the 660' as required by the Oil Conservation Division.
