Attached in duplicate (to each office) are a well location plat C-102 with a sketch of the surrounding conditions and an ownership plat for the above captioned well.

This well was originally staked at 1790 FSL, 1100 FEL. It had to be moved because of proximity to the existing road and the existing well as sketched on the C-102. Geological consideration prevented moving the well to the south and west. The proposed location is the only acceptable site for this well.
