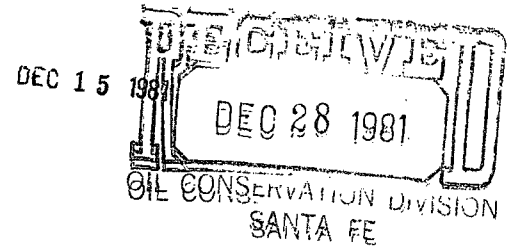


LAND PLAT
