

Gentlemen:

This is a request for administrative approval for an unorthodox gas well location in the Blanco Mesa Verde Pool.

It is intended to locate the El Paso Natural Gas Company's Neudecker #3 at 1840' from the North Line and 2140' from the East Line of Section 35, T-29-N, R-10-W, San Juan County, New Mexico.

Due to the existing houses, pipeline, and irrigated farm land in the northeast corner of this section it is impossible to build an orthodox gas well location.

A copy of this application is being submitted to all offset operators by certified mail with a request that they furnish your Santa Fe office with a Waiver of Objection, and return a copy to this office.


Plats showing the proposed well location and the terrain of Section 35, along with an ownership plat, are attached.




