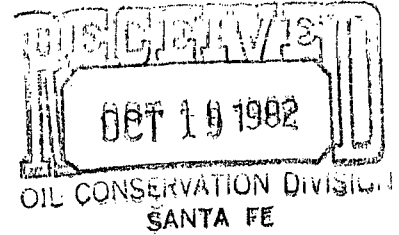

Gentlemen:

We are currently in the process of filing a 9-331C (Application for Permit to drill) and C-102 (Proration Unit Plat) with the Minerals Management Service in Roswell, New Mexico for a permit to drill a second Jalmat Gas Well as an infill well to the same producing interval on an existing 160-acre non-standard proration unit comprised of the NE/4 of Section 5, T-25-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico. The subject 160-acre non-standard proration unit is currently dedicated to the Wells "B-5" No. 1 Jalmat Gas Well located in A-5-25S-37E. The proposed new well will be drilled at an unorthodox location consisting of 1552' FNL and 2230' FEL of Section 5, T-25-S, R-37-E.

Therefore, we hereby file for administrative approval to drill the proposed well at the unorthodox location of 1552' FNL and 2230' FEL of Section 5 and to simultaneously dedicate the 160-acre non-standard proration unit comprised of the NE/4 Section 5, T-25-S, R-37-E to both the existing Jalmat Gas Well (Wells "B-5" No. 1 located in A-5-25S-37E) and to our proposed new well (Wells "B-5" No. 2 located in G-5-25S-37E).

Furthermore, if the proposed well is completed as a commercial producer, and in compliance with the Natural Gas Policy Act of 1978, an application will also be submitted to the appropriate jurisdictional agencies to obtain administrative approval for the well as a Section 103 infill well location on a previously existing proration unit.

As to our request for an unorthodox location, the requested location is necessitated by numerous oil and gas pipelines, flowlines, powerlines, injection lines, trunklines and roads located in this area. The Union Texas Petroleum Corporation Langlie-Jal Unit central tank battery and water injection station are located in the center of Section 5 and is the reason for all the pipelines and other obstructions. I have attached a sketch of the surface showing the location of pipelines and roads.

Three copies of a plat showing the location of the original well on the existing 160-acre proration unit plus the location of the proposed well are enclosed.



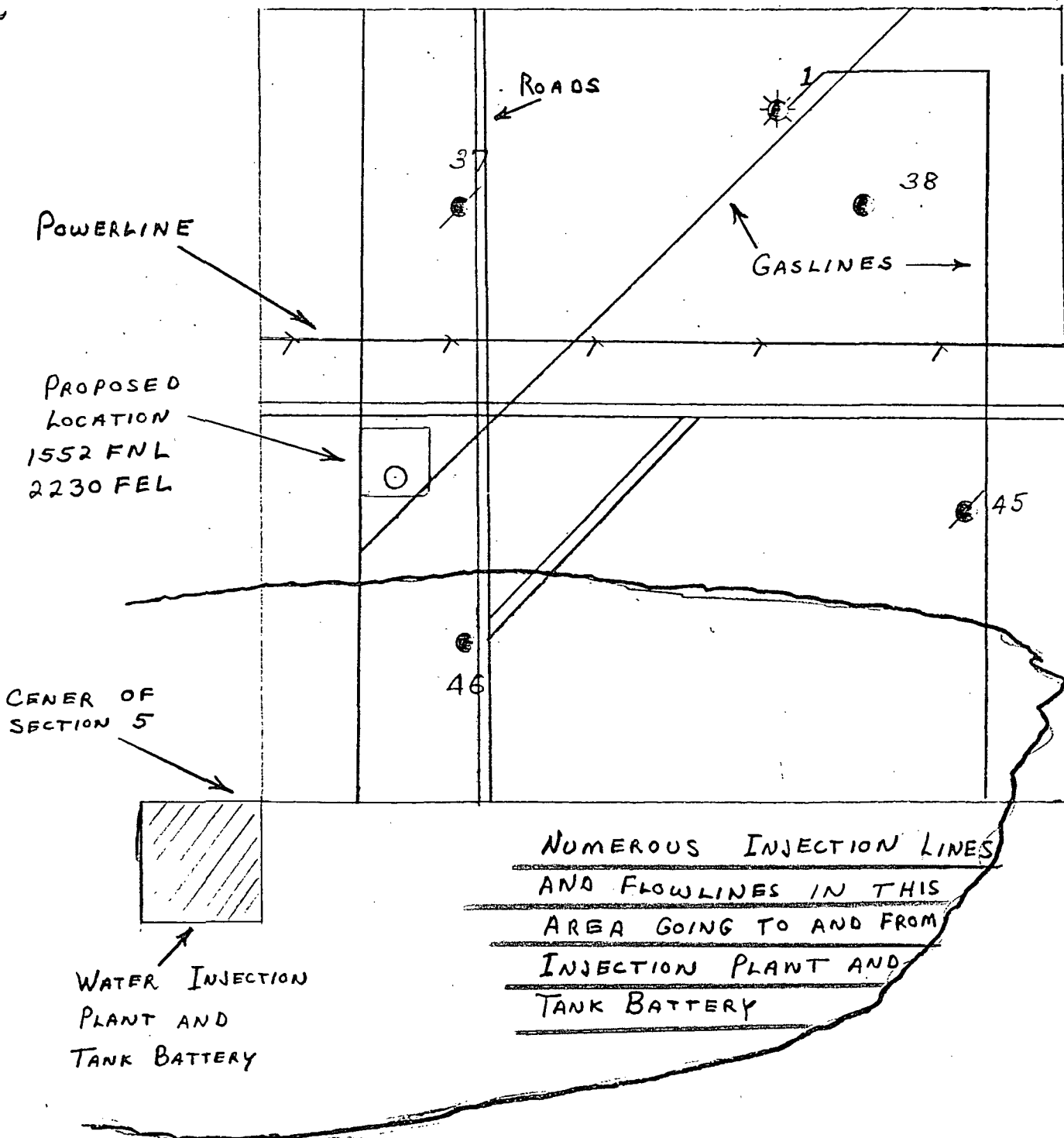
