Gentlemen:

In the near future, we plan to file a 9-331C and C-102 with the Bureau of Land Management District Office in Roswell for permission to drill a new Jalmat gas well as a Section 103 infill well at a non-standard location consisting of 810' FNL and 460' FWL Section 5, T-25-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico. The subject well will be drilled on an existing 160-acre non-standard Jalmat (Gas) proration unit comprised of the NW/4 Section 5 (NSP-358). At the present, the subject 160-acre tract is dedicated to the El Paso Natural Gas Company-operated (soon to be Doyle Hartman-operated) Wells Federal No. 4 (F-5-25S-37E) which is a Jalmat (Gas) producer, and upon the drilling and completion of the newly proposed Wells Federal No. 15, both the Wells Federal No. 15 and the Wells Federal No. 4 will be simultaneously dedicated to the existing 160-acre proration unit consisting of the NW/4 Section 5.

Therefore, we hereby file for administrative approval to simultaneously dedicate the new infill well (Wells Federal No. 15) along with the Wells Federal No. 4 to the existing 160-acre non-standard Jalmat (Gas) proration unit comprised of the NW/4 Section 5, T-25-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico.

Furthermore, if the proposed well is completed as a commercial producer, and in compliance with the Natural Gas Policy of 1978, an application will also be submitted to the Bureau of Land Management to obtain administrative approval for the well as a Section 103 infill well.

Dear Mr. Stamets:

Reference is made to Doyle Hartman's letter dated April 11, 1984, requesting administrative approval for the simultaneous dedication of an existing 160-acre non-standard gas proration unit comprising the NW/4 of Section 5, Township 25 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Jalmat Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico, to the El Paso Natural Gas Company-operated (soon to be Doyle Hartman-operated) Wells Federal Well No. 4, located in Unit F of said Section 5, and to a proposed new well, being the Wells Federal Well No. 15, to be drilled at an unorthodox location 810 feet from the North line and 460 feet from the West line of said Section 5.

Apparently some question has arisen concerning the necessity for the proposed unorthodox location of Well No. 15, and in order to help clarify this matter, I am attaching hereto another copy of the previously submitted sketch of the NW/4 of Section 5, Township 25 South, Range 37 East.

You will note that there is already in existence a well in the approximate center of each 40-acre tract in the 160-acre proration unit. Further, that numerous roads, water

injection lines, and gas lines, as well as a power line, criss-crossing the 160-acre tract, render a standard location impracticable, if not impossible.

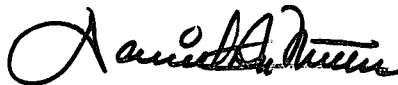
In view of the above-described topographic features, it was necessary to locate Well No. 15 at a point 810 feet from the North line and 460 feet from the West line of Section 5.

In accordance with the provisions of Rule 3, Section 1 of the General Rules and Regulations for Prorated Gas Pools, Southeast New Mexico, as contained in Division Order No. R-1670 as amended, and on behalf of Mr. Hartman, it is respectfully requested that approval be given for this proposed unorthodox location based upon topographic conditions.

We would further request that this letter be regarded simply as an explanatory letter describing the necessity for the unorthodox location as being based on topography, and ask that the original letter dated April 11, 1984, be considered the official application, with calculation of the 20-day waiting period commencing on that date, when notice was given to all offset operators.

Approval of this application at your earliest convenience will be greatly appreciated.
