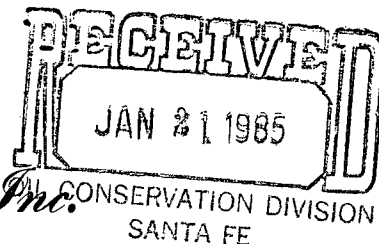
Vicinity Map

DEVELOPMENT PLAN FOR SURFACE USE

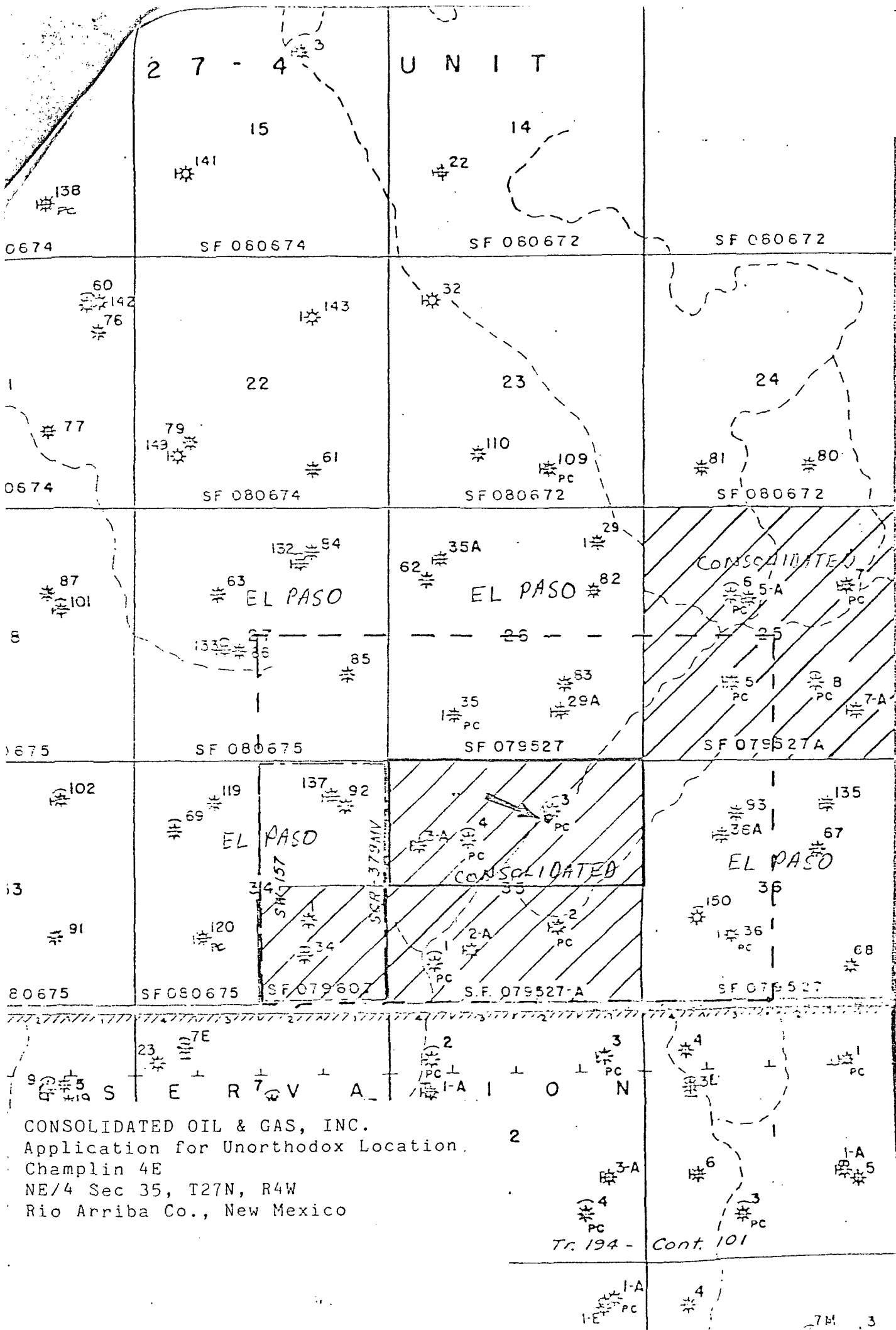

 DECLINATION AT CENTER OF SHEET



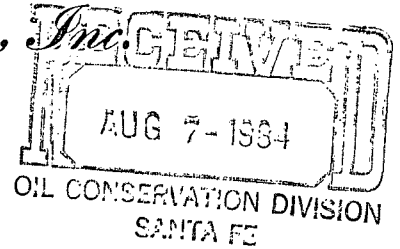
