Reference is made to your application for a non-standard location for your Gallegos Canyon Unit Well No. 178E to be located 2185 feet from the North line and 355 feet from the East line of Section 4, Township 27 North, Range 12 West, NMPM, Basin-Dakota and Wildcat Gallup, San Juan County, New Mexico. The E/2 of Section 4 shall be dedicated to the Basin Dakota Pool and the SE/4 NE/4 of Section 4 shall be dedicated to the Wildcat Gallup Pool.
