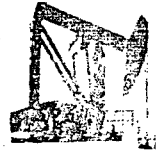

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for a non-standard location for your Wells Federal Well No. 19 located 660 feet from the South line and 2310 feet from the East line, Section 4, Township 25 South, Range 37 East, the W/2 E/2 of said Section 4 to be dedicated to the well, Lea County, New Mexico.

Also, you are hereby authorized to simultaneously dedicate an existing 160-acre proration unit, previously approved by NSP-308 and comprising the W/2 E/2 of said Section 4 to your Wells Federal Well No. 19 located in Unit O and your Wells Federal Well No. 2 located in Unit G of said Section, Lea County, New Mexico. Further, you are hereby permitted to produce the allowable from any of the wells on the proration unit in any proportion.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 104 F(I) of the Division Rules and Regulations, the above-described unorthodox location is hereby approved.
