Reference is made to your application for a non-standard location for your Hancock Well No. 6M to be located 1025 feet from the South line and 530 feet from the East line of Section 29, Township 28 North, Range 9 West, NMPM, Blanco Mesaverde Pool and Basin Dakota Pools, San Juan County, New Mexico. The S/2 of said Section 29 shall be dedicated to the Blanco Mesaverde and Basin Dakota Pools.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule  $104 \, \mathrm{F}(\mathrm{I})$ , the above-described unorthodox location is hereby approved.
