

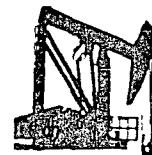

Reference is made to your application for two non-standard locations in the Langlie-Mattix and Jalmat Pools in Township 25 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico:

Langlie-Jal Unit #108 Well to be located 1275' FEL and 2575' FSL of Sec. 5; the NE/4 SE/4 of said Section 5 to be dedicated to the well; and
